3. Business Arising From Minutes

1. Tabled from last meeting:

- Football officials have not had raise for over ten years
- We are looking at \$5.00 raise (from 30.00 to \$35.00 for A officials and from \$27.00 to \$32.00 for B officials)
- **MOTION:** "I make the motion to increase the officials pay for football (from 30.00 to \$35.00 for A officials and from \$27.00 to \$32.00 for B officials) and that we make this retroactive to the beginning of this year's football season" (S. Hutchinson/B. Symenuk—carried)
- **MOTION:** I make the motion to increase all the minor official's pay for football by \$2.00 (Announcer from \$20.00 to \$22.00, Stats and Stick from \$15.00 to \$17.00)" (B. Moser/S. Hutchinson—carried)
- **MOTION:** "I make the motion to increase the official pay for soccer from \$28.00 to \$32.00 and to make this retroactive to the start of the season" (S. Hutchinson/B. Symenuk—carried)
- it is advised that the basketball officials meet and consider their rates
- we would be in favor of increasing the volleyball officials rate; we are waiting for the officials association to come forward

- a. Football (Larry Segall):

 - Stats will be out shortly

- d. Cross Country (Renee Verge)
 - there were Districts last week, it was well received
 - there are provincials this weekend in Regina
- e. Soccer (Larry Segall)
 - the Invitational went well
 - the report is not completed because we are waiting for some of the bills as well as donations made from Bonnie at Sasktel (\$300.00)
 - there are playoffs next week
 - there will be 2 reps that will go to the SHSAA regionals
- f. Golf (Martin Holzer)
 - districts: congrats to Central
 - discussion on changing the format of having chaperones walking around with golfers
 - discussion on high score shooters
 - TABLED:** how do we eliminate excessive high scores?
- g. Basketball
 - Invitational –we lost two teams in the last two weeks
 - other three sections of South Central are hosting tournaments (in place of league) and South Central will cover cost
 - who will pay for tournament?
 - CCS is now part of the association—maybe we should run a tournament and absorb their costs or they could run their own tournament and they would receive the profits
 - TABLED:** do we enter one more team from the MJSHAD in the invitational?
 - Cornerstone—talk to Roger Morgan from South Central to discuss the officials cost-they would like some funding
 - ACTION:** could we see a proposal for a tournament if Cornerstone is wanting to host one (expenses, officiating costs, etc.)
