### **Recommendation**

- not to have more than 16 competitors per event
- (no more than 4 heats in 100 & 200 m races)
- No grade 8's competing

### **NEW BUISNESS**

1. **a) Proposal** to expand the 100m to 4 entries per conference to accommodate a more competitive relay team at Provincials

b) One relay team per conference at District meet

### **2. Qualifying for the District Meet**

- Each area must have their own conference meet to decide on entries for districts
- City meet will include PA City (Carlton, St. Mary, Rivier) and PA Small Schools (same as above)
- Unlimited entries per event in this meet

### **Suggestion to facilitate the running of the City & District meets:**

Run boys pole vault & 4 classes of jumps as well as the 200m & Distance races on WEDNESDAY evening  
(SR Girls & SR Boys Long Jump & MG & JR Boys Triple)

- Records will be recorded as PA & area records
- Points will be awarded each school counts points Top 6
- individual school points Top 3 per conference (Carlton, St. Mary & Small Schools)
- 1<sup>st</sup>= 10, 2<sup>nd</sup> =8, 3<sup>rd</sup>=6, 4<sup>th</sup>=3, 5<sup>th</sup>=2, 6<sup>th</sup>=1
- Scratches: treat Wed & Thurs. as separate days based on the coach's discretion
- Track vs Field events which takes president? Must ask to do field event early or late, if too late than missed (ie) high jump, can't drop bar

### **3. How to involve other schools within North Central to facilitate the meet**

- Rotational basis, with the following representative numbers from each area  
2 Carlton, 2 PA Small Schools, 1 Catholic, 1 Parkland, 1 Missinipe

### **4. How to make selections for the Provincial team from our District results?**

- The top 2 athletes in each event attend Provincials. If the athlete is not able to attend, then the 3<sup>rd</sup> place winner shall go in place (based on coach's discretion of the level of competition of 3<sup>rd</sup> place), if 3<sup>rd</sup> place cannot go, then the 7 member Track & Field committee will decide on a replacement

### **5. Financial Aspect of the Provincial Meet**

- The NCDAA cannot fund travel for the Provincial meet. Athletes and /or schools must fund their own travel & accommodation costs.
- Students from Saskatchewan Rivers will travel together in a team bus

3. Assignments for events will be included with change of schedule

Jumps: St. Mary's & PA Sm. Schools

Blocks/Starters/Timer & Photo finish: will all be set up by track officials

Shot put: set up by those manning the station
