

**District Information**  
**Provincial High School Track & Field Championships**  
**June 4 & 5**  
**Gutheridge Field, Moose Jaw, SK.**

Please note the following:

**1. Scratches:** Please meet at 9:00 AM with Kevin Vollet at the Awards tent.

**2. Officials' Meeting:** 9:30 AM at the Sound Booth.

**3. Admissions**

*a. Competitors*

- i. **Registration** will take place in the gymnasium at Riverview Collegiate adjacent to Gutheridge Field. Please enter the school through the main doors (off Coteau Street) where you will be directed to the gymnasium and your District table for registration. Room will be made for vehicles including busses to pull over outside of the main entrance on Coteau Street. Athletes/coaches will register in the gymnasium and then exit the school through the west doors which will lead you to Gutheridge Field. Identify yourself by name and district and you will receive a wrist band that will allow you to enter the park free of charge.
- ii. The **wristband must be worn the entire meet**. Failure to show your admission wristband will result in admission being collected.

*b. Coaches*

- i. You will be required to register at the Athlete registration tables located in the gymnasium of Riverview Collegiate. You will also receive a wristband and must **wear wristband the entire meet** otherwise admission will be charged.

*c. **General Public – admission gate will be located at the west end of Gutheridge Field** (no general admission through the gymnasium registration area)*

- i. Adult Admission: \$6.00 per day. Student Admission: \$4.00 per day.
- ii. A two day wrist band can be purchased on Friday.

**4. Programs**

- a. Available free of charge at the Admissions Gate.

**5. Washrooms**

- a. Porta-potties will be available around the facility for athlete and official use. Washrooms are also located inside of Riverview Collegiate (gymnasium hallway and front lobby only) and in the football locker rooms just east of the high jump area.

**6. Coaches Meeting**

- a. Saturday, June 5<sup>th</sup> during the noon break.
- b. This meeting will take place in Riverview Collegiate on the stage. Please enter school through the west doors and the stage will be the first door on your right as you enter the building. District coaches (**2 per district**) will be provided with free lunch.

## 7. Marshalling of Athletes

- a. Field events will be marshaled at the event site.
- b. Track events will be marshaled at the marshalling tent.

## 8. Medal and Ribbon Presentations

- a. Field Events
  - i. At the conclusion of each field event the head official will be requested to bring the top competitors (1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>) to the Awards tent. Then the head official can proceed directly to the announcers' booth with the results. Ribbons will be presented to finishers 4 – 8 while medals will be presented to the top 3.
- b. Track Events
  - i. Within ½ hour of the conclusion of each track event, the top 8 competitors will be called to the Awards tent/Podium for presentations.
- c. **Please remind your athletes they must wear their District uniform for award presentations.**

## 9. Concessions

- a. Plans are for 3 concession areas to be set up. Both Quiznos Subs and Western Pizza will set up a concession booth. Riverview Collegiate will also operate a concession on the ground floor of the Announcer's booth.

## 10. Reminders

- a. There are bleachers to sit on at Gutheridge Field but there is also a hill to utilize adjacent to the bleachers. Bring lawn chairs and blankets. We encourage all competitors, coaches and fans to bring plenty of sunscreen, wear a hat and to drink plenty of fluids.

## 11. Parking

- a. Parking is at the west end of the Gutheridge. Riverview's parking lot may be used on Saturday.

## 12. Athlete registration

- a. Please note registration procedures in the **admission sections** of this document. Coaches are asked to send the entire athlete delegation through the lines rather than the coaches picking up all of the athlete wristbands.
- b. ***Saturday and late Friday athlete registrations***
  - i. Athletes are to enter through the admission gate on the west end Gutheridge Field to register and pick up their wristband.

## 13. Medical Facilities

- a. All coaches should equip themselves with the standard first-aid supplies **including tape**, as with any other activity. Ice will be available and an ambulance and EMS staff will be on site.
