Categories of Competition:

Senior – 16 and over as of August 31st, 2011

Junior – under 16 as of August 31st, 2011

Midget – under 15 as of August 31st, 2011

Wheelchair Events: The 100m and 400m wheelchair events have been approved as events for this meet. Please contact the SHSAA office with entries for the wheel chair events.

QUADATHLON: *The Quadathlon is a new event added to the SHSAA schedule by resolution at the 2010 AGM.*

- *There will be a Boys Quadathlon competition and a Girls Quadathlon competition.*
 - *Each competition will be an open category.*
- *The Quadathlon will consist of four events (100m, 800m, Long Jump, and Shot Put) that are scored based on the best performance by the individual in each of the events.*
 - *The winner of the Quadathlon will be the competitor who has accumulated the most points through the four events.*
- *All four events for the Quadathlon will take place on Friday June 1, 2012 as per the SHSAA track schedule.*
- *Athletes participating in the Quadathlon will not be allowed to compete in other individual events at the SHSAA Track and Field Championships but may compete in any age appropriate relays entered by their District.*
- *All athletes competing in the Quadathlon at the SHSAA Track and Field Championships are expected to have competed in a similar event at their District Track Meet.*
- *Shot Put implement*
 - *Boys – 12 lb. Implement*
 - *Girls – 4 kg. implement*

HY-TEK will be the program used for this year's meet. The district team advancers are listed on the SHSAA web site. There are four methods in which to advance the district entries to the provincial meet, one of which is still the FAST TRACK program. Entries are due to the SHSAA office on or before May 28th, 2012. Substitutions for original entries may be made until 4:00pm on May 30th, 2012.

OFFICIALS' ASSIGNMENTS: Each District must supply **TWO OFFICIALS per session** for the meet. These officials will be assigned an event or task for each session of the meet with the Head Officials for each event being appointed by the host District. **Please supply the names of your District officials to the SHSAA Office as soon as possible following your District Track meet.** A fine of \$100.00 will be assessed to any District that does not comply with these criteria. Athletes must not be assigned as officials.
