The information printed here will include all preliminary material that teams will need for the play-offs. Schedules and volleyball information are found in the SHSAA Handbook and listed below. The SHSAA office will seed each tournament, the Monday prior to the conference, regional or provincial tournament.

- **Seeding** of the provincial PLAYOFFS is important to the success of the championship. All teams **MUST** submit the results of their season to the **SHSAA office before October 27**. Include results of all matches played up to that date.
- The provincial final tournaments for 1A to 4A will follow the twelve-team round robin – 2 pools – 2 courts draw on page 115 of the SHSAA handbook.
- The 5A provincial final tournaments will follow a ten-team round robin – 2 pools – 2 courts draw on page 116 of the SHSAA handbook.
- Some modification of the draw times may be necessary to accommodate host plans. The SHSAA office must approve any changes to the draw.
- **Accommodations** in some locations may be limited. If your championship is near a city with a Comfort Inn, blocks of rooms have been set aside for the playoff. Rooms may also be blocked at the Saskatoon Inn, Regina Inn and Quality Inns.
- **SHSAA Web Site** has a message board where we encourage schools to post results of league and tournament play during the season. There are many interested visitors to the site interested in your results.
- **Results of all conference, regional and provincial final tournaments** will be posted on the SHSAA web site (www.shsaa.ca) direct from the event. You can track each event by clicking on the SHSAA RESULTS tab listed in the directory on the News and Events page.

2006 CONFERENCE VOLLEYBALL TOURNAMENTS

CONFERENCE DATES: **1A, 2A, 3A, 4A Girls - November 4, 2006**
 1A, 2A, 3A, 4A Boys - November 10, 2006

- In the 1A to 4A classifications, each conference event will determine the teams that will advance to regional playoffs. Depending on the number of groups in each conference the top two or three teams will advance to regional play.
- ***In conferences with three groups, each group will advance two teams to the regional tournament.***
- ***In conferences with two groups, each group will advance three teams to the regional tournament.***
- The **four and five-team** conference tournament will consist of a full round robin with no playoff round. This will be a one-day event.
- The **six, seven and eight-team** conference tournament will consist of two-pools for round-robin play followed by a single elimination crossover playoff to determine the teams that will advance to the regional tournament. The six-team event is a one-day event. The seven and eight-team draws will require a day and a half to complete.

- In the 5A classification, there will be four regional events: Saskatoon, Regina, North and South. Saskatoon and Regina will advance two teams to the provincial determined through their respective league playoffs. The North and South regional tournaments will consist of seven, eight or nine teams. The seven-team tournament will be a full round robin. The eight or nine team tournaments will consist of a two-pool round robin followed by the top three teams advancing to a single-elimination crossover playoff. The North and South Regional will advance three teams to provincial. The Regional that includes the provincial host will only advance two teams plus the host school to the provincial.
- The 1A – 4A tournaments will consist of six teams. The regional playoff will consist of a two-pool round robin play followed by **all six teams advancing to a single elimination crossover playoff**. Three teams in each regional will qualify for the provincial championship tournament, unless the provincial host school is part of that regional, in that event two teams plus the host will advance.
