Canada Basketball and the **Canadian School Sport Federation (CSSF)**, through the Provincial/Territorial High School Athletic Association governing bodies (**SHSAA**), would like to announce the Canada Basketball Scholarship Program. Established in 2006, these scholarships will be offered to a deserving male and female high school basketball player, **(two scholarships valued at \$1,250.00 each.) A scholarship of \$1,250.00** will be awarded to a worthy male and female high school basketball player in Saskatchewan. We would like you to recommend one male and one female student-athlete from your school for the opportunity to win one of these scholarships.

CSSF and the various Provincial/Territorial Athletic Associations warmly thank Canada Basketball for their tireless efforts in the promotion of our student-athletes. We hope that you will take the time to invest in the further development of today's youth by submitting qualified candidates by the requested due date.

Applicants will be scored on their academic success, leadership in the amateur sport community through well-rounded participation as a high school basketball athlete, as well as on the basis of their other school and community activities. The player must have a proficiency in basketball and meet all of the eligibility requirements of a high school student athlete as outlined in the constitution of the Saskatchewan High Schools Athletic Association. The selection will be based on the individuals who best exemplified the ideals of the student-athlete who is continuing their post-secondary education in Canada.

We ask that, if you feel you have an individual of this caliber that you meet with this player and ask them to fill in the required information and assist them in obtaining the required letters of support. The athlete must submit four (4) stapled copies of their completed application, a recent picture (maximum size 6.5 cm x 9 cm) and sign the release of information form included in the application.

Applications must be received by or postmarked no later than May 15, 2008. The successful applicants names will be forwarded to Canada Basketball by May 30, 2008 with a joint announcement made after this date.
