RE: BASKETBALL CONFERENCES – FINAL Draft

The final draft has been completed based on updates submitted by schools to the SHSAA office.

Please check to see that your school's teams have been included in a conference.

- **If your school is not listed, you must contact the SHSAA office.**
- **If your school is listed and your school will not form a team, also contact the office.**

Please check that your school's basketball teams have been placed in the proper classification.

The population ranges for each category was amended at the 2006 AGM and are as follows:

- 5A – 251 or more students in grades 10 – 12 in Saskatoon and Regina
- 4A – 151 or more students in grades 10 – 12
- 3A – 51 – 150 students in grades 10 – 12
- 2A – 31 – 50 students in grades 10 – 12
- 1A – 1 – 30 students in grades 10 - 12

In each of the following conferences (1A – 3A Boys and Girls), **two teams** will advance to the regional playoff tournaments. The teams that qualify from the conference tournaments will then be seeded 1 to 16 and placed in one of four regional tournaments, which will qualify one team to Hoopla 2008.

In the 4A Boys category, each conference tournament will advance **four teams** to the regional playoff tournaments. The teams that qualify from the conference tournaments will also be seeded 1 – 16 and placed in one of four regional tournaments to qualify one team to Hoopla 2008.

In the 5A category, each of the two conferences (Regina and Saskatoon) will advance the top four teams to Hoopla.

- **All conference tournaments will be played on February 29 & March 1, 2008.**
- **All regional tournaments will be played on March 7 & 8, 2008.**
- **HOOPLA 2008 will take place in Saskatoon on March 13, 14 & 15, 2008.**

Seeding forms (www.shsaa.ca) are due in the SHSAA office by Feb. 22, 2008.

In the following tables, the school that appears in **bold** print is the school that has been designated by their district to host the conference tournament. There are a few conferences left to be designated with host sites. Once they have been designated, updates will be posted to the web site.

District Presidents will then forward the host location to the office.
