

## **2009 PROVINCIAL SOCCER CHAMPIONSHIPS** – updated September 22

### **SPORT SPECIFICS:**

Please refer to the SHSAA handbook for details of hosting and playoff procedures. Follow all registration and competitive procedures as outlined in the **BYLAWS** section of the handbook.

### **ELIGIBILITY:**

Student athlete eligibility form (**Form E-5**) for Soccer is due on, or before, **September 9th**. Forms must be filled out and filed on-line via the SHSAA web site ([www.shsaa.ca](http://www.shsaa.ca)).

**REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS – playoffs will take place on October 23<sup>th</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>**. Templates for Regional (3, 4, 5 or 6 teams) and Provincial (4 or 8 teams) Soccer draws can be found on the SHSAA web site.

**Soccer Regional groupings are posted on the website, based on the information provided by the September 9<sup>th</sup> E-5 forms and indication of intent from schools eligible to partake in the 7 vs. 7. Some regional hosts have been named and others are still to be determined.** After September 30<sup>th</sup> enrolment declarations are completed, schools that have a change of 25% or more in enrolment that causes the school to change classification from the previous year will be reclassified and placed in an appropriate region. The SHSAA office will seed all regional and provincial tournaments. It is imperative that all soccer teams complete and forward a seeding form to the SHSAA office by **October 16<sup>th</sup>**.

In all categories, each region, through a seeded tournament, will advance two teams to the provincial championship tournament. Regions that are composed of leagues will advance two teams through their league playoff format. If the provincial host team is in the region then that region will advance one team to the provincial championship in addition to the provincial host team.

### **THE FOLLOWING ARE EXCEPTIONS TO REGIONAL PLAY AND ADVANCEMENT TO THE PROVINCIAL TOURNAMENT:**

***The 7 vs. 7 classification for both boys and girls will consist of two regional tournaments which will each advance two teams to the four team provincial championship. The provincial host will be named following the completion of Regional play. SCHOOLS THAT WOULD BE WILLING TO HOST THE PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIP ARE ASKED TO CONTACT THE SHSAA OFFICE prior to Regional weekend.***

***There will be no Regional play in the 1A Girls category. If needed, play in games among the lowest seeded teams will determine the provincial championship field of 8 teams.***

***The 2A Boys Regional play will consist of two Regional tournaments involving teams outside of the City of Regina. Region A will advance three representatives to the provincial championship, Region C will advance two teams in addition to the provincial host team and there will be two representatives from the City of Regina.***
