Volleyball Clinics

1. MONDAY, AUGUST 31st, there will be a clinic in Clavet starting at 7:00 pm. This clinic is aimed at two groups: students/young adults interested in becoming officials for junior volleyball and/or working as minor officials at provincials. Conducted by Grant Elke, it will conclude by 9:30 pm. Those attending are asked to come prepared to participate and to bring a whistle.
2. WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 2nd, there will be a clinic at Allan starting at 7:00. This will be a two tiered clinic. In the gymnasium, there will a clinic conducted by Grant Elke, similar to the one taking place in Clavet. There will also be a clinic offered for those interested in officiating high school volleyball. This clinic, put on by clinician Lori Mills, will include SVA registration for qualified officials for the upcoming year.
 - a. **Any senior student or community member wishing to establish their standing as an official can combine this clinic, which would give them their level B standing, with attendance at either of the Osler tournaments on October 17th and 24th to get floor tested and to write the local level exam, to become a full level A official. With clinician approval, they will be given the opportunity to officiate at conference and regional playoffs this year.**
3. WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 9th, there will be a clinic in Saskatoon with the location to be announced at the CVAC meeting on Thursday. This will be a clinic for those interested in

officiating high school volleyball. It is being hosted by the Saskatoon region. It is important for any official who registers through the Saskatoon region, to contact Grant Elke so that they are placed upon the CVAC registry, too.

4. THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 10th, there will be a clinic offered at Warman High starting at 7:00. This will again be a two tiered clinic, in the gymnasium for those interested in officiating junior volleyball and in the classroom for those wishing to either register as a qualified official or begin their journey as a volleyball official.
 - a. **Attendance at this clinic, combined with successful floor and paper work at an Osler tournament, should gain a new official their level A standing and an opportunity to officiate at junior and/or senior playoffs.**
5. There may also be a clinic in Asquith the following week based upon perceived need in the western side of our district. The decision will be made at the CVAC meeting.
