Applicants were scored on their academic success, leadership in the amateur sport community through well-rounded participation as a high school basketball athlete, as well as on the basis of their other school and community activities. The selection was based on the individuals who best exemplified the ideals of a student-athlete and who will continue their post-secondary education in Canada.

Kendra Morrow – Outlook High School

- Kendra plans to attend the University of Saskatchewan to obtain a Bachelor of Science degree and then pursue a career in Dentistry or Medicine
- Participant in the Basketball Saskatchewan 'Top 50' program since grade six
- Participant in the Canada Basketball Centre for Performance program during 2005-2006
- Guard on the Outlook Blues basketball team named team MVP and winner of Dedication & Sportsmanship Awards. She averaged 15 points per game, 9 rebounds and 6 assists per game.
- Appeared at Hoopla in 2004 and 2006
- Member of the school SRC, Yearbook committee, Band, SADD, cross-country team, volleyball team, badminton team, track team. A youth companion mentor and a bantam girls basketball coach
- Kendra is an outstanding academic student achieving an average of 96% in grade ten, 97% in grade eleven and currently has an average of 95% in grade twelve

Jane Jacoby – Regina Sheldon-Williams Collegiate

- Jane plans to attend Medicine Hat College to pursue a Bachelor of Applied Arts in Visual Communications and to play basketball
- Member of Team Saskatchewan basketball team at the 2005 Canada Games and Team Saskatchewan at the 2002 & 2003 nationals
- Guard for the Sheldon Williams Spartans, named city all-star in grades ten, eleven and twelve. Highest scorer in the city junior girls league in 2003. Appeared at Hoopla in 2006. She averaged 15 points per game, 2 rebounds, 3 steals and 6 assists per game.
- Selected to participate in the Canada Basketball Centre for Performance
- Member of school SRC, SADD committee, Sheldon basketball tournament organization committee, peer support team for two years, volunteer at 'Run for the Cure' - breast cancer fundraiser and a basketball referee for the past four years.
- Jane has been on the school honour roll for three consecutive years

Kris Heshka – Yorkton Regional High School

- Kris plans to attend the University of Regina to obtain a Bachelor of Education degree in secondary and physical education
- Member of Team Saskatchewan in 2003 and 2004, selected as a 2nd team all-star at nationals in Halifax
- Member of the Team Saskatchewan basketball team at the 2005 Canada Games that won a bronze medal.
- Attended the All-Canada camps in 2004, 2005 and participated in the All-Canadian game in 2006
- A power forward that lead the Yorkton Regional Raiders to the 2005 Provincial Championship at Hoopla. He averaged 24.8 points per game, 13 rebounds, 4 blocks per game and 3 assists per game.
- SRC vice-president in grade eleven and president in grade twelve, member of school volleyball team, football team, track team, a volunteer canvasser for Red Cross to collect pledges, coach of elementary school girls basketball team.
- Kris has been on the school honour roll for three consecutive years

- Jacob plans to attend the University of Regina to obtain an Engineering degree
- Member of Team Saskatchewan in 2003 and an alternate member of the Team Saskatchewan basketball team at the 2005 Canada Games
- Sheldon Williams Spartans basketball team captain grades 10, 11 and 12, grade 11 and 12 city all-star, 2006 city champions and silver medalist in the 6A category at Hoopla 2006. He averaged 16 points per game, 5 rebounds, 7 assists and 6 steals per game.
- Member of school SRC, volleyball and rugby team captain in grades 10, 11 and 12, track team, coach of bantam basketball teams last two years. Referees volleyball and basketball and is committed to continue to participate in sport as an official.
- Jacob has been on Sheldon's academic honour role for the past four years and maintains a 90% average.
