ELIGIBILITY: Student athlete eligibility forms (E - 5) must be filed in the Provincial office prior to **September 13th**. Forms must be filled out and filed on-line via the SHSAA web site (www.shsaa.ca). Click on the Forms button and enter the SHSAA ExNet – Members Login. Your school Principal will have the school's USER I.D. and PASSWORD.

OFFICIALS: Game officials for all post conference or post league games are assigned, and paid, by the SHSAA Office. The assignments are done by the District Officials Commissioner and must be approved by the SHSAA office.

SPECIAL RULES: Please note the information in the SHSAA HANDBOOK, Activities section relating to your particular category of Football. Note the overtime procedure for high school football.

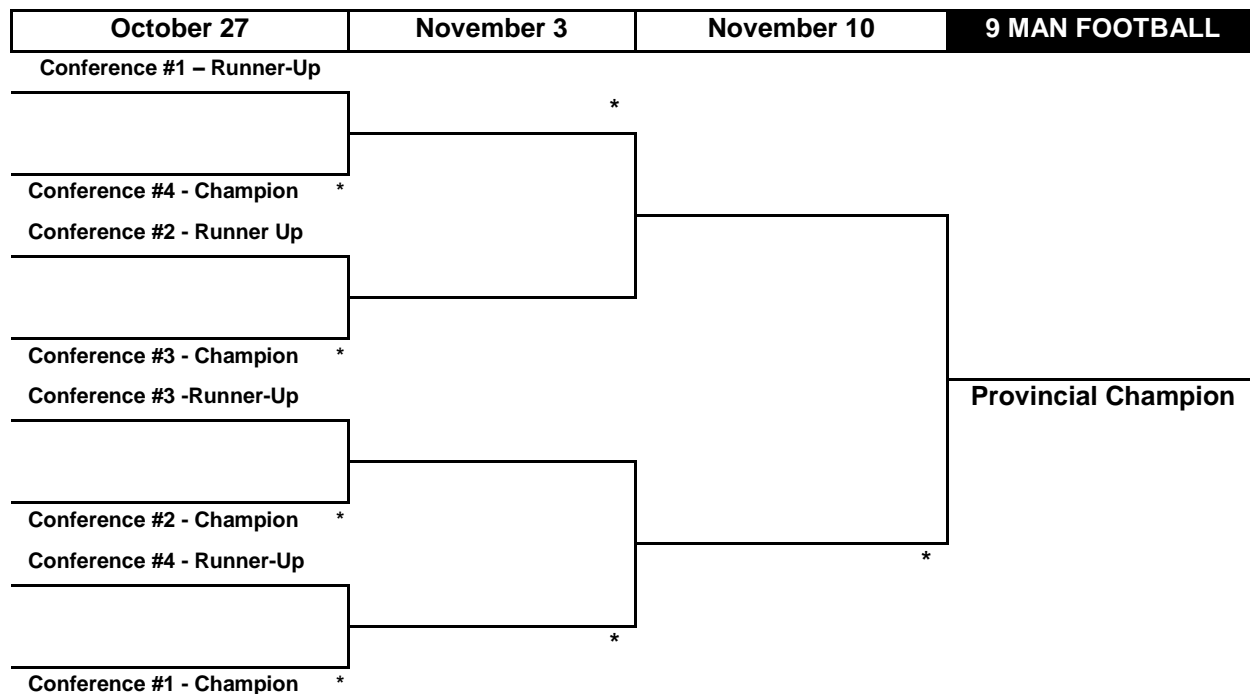

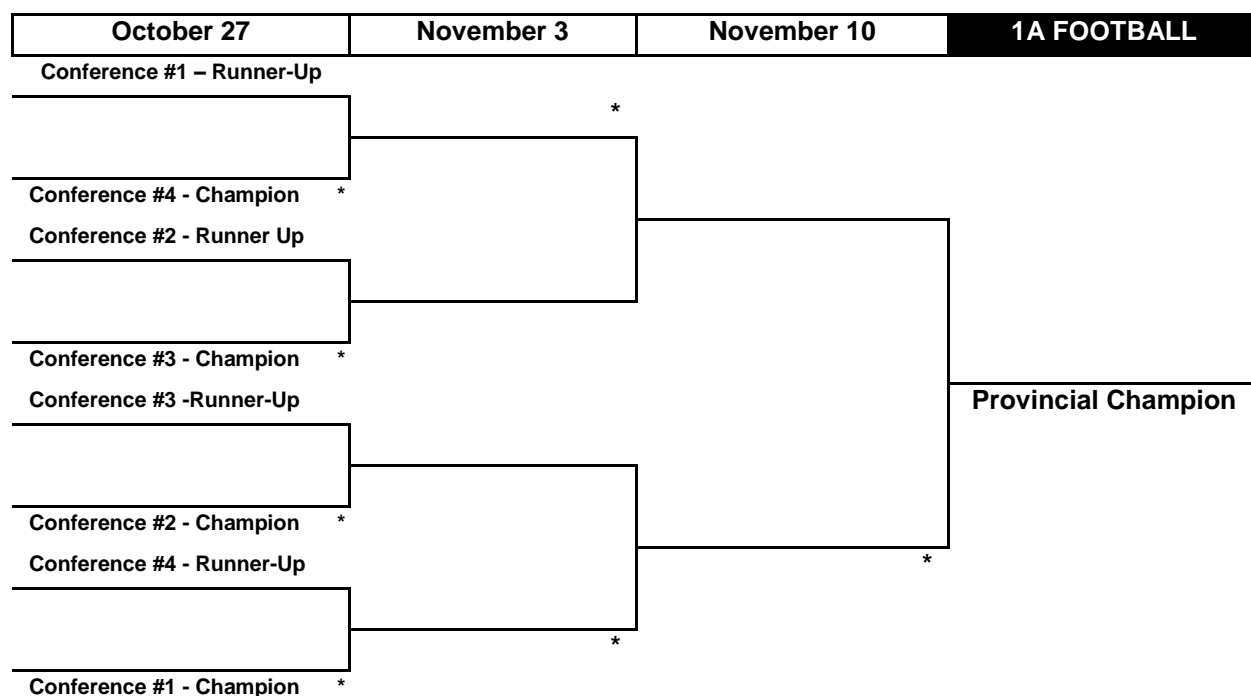

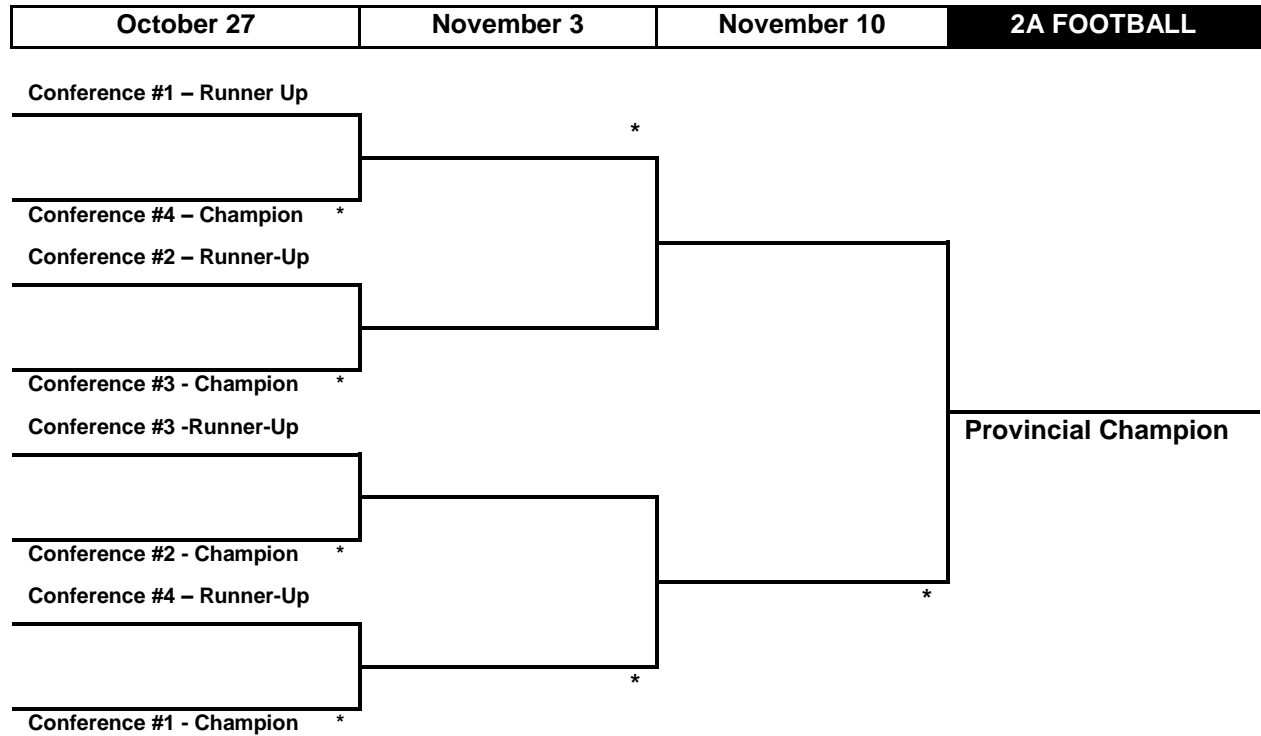

"2A" 6 MAN FOOTBALL



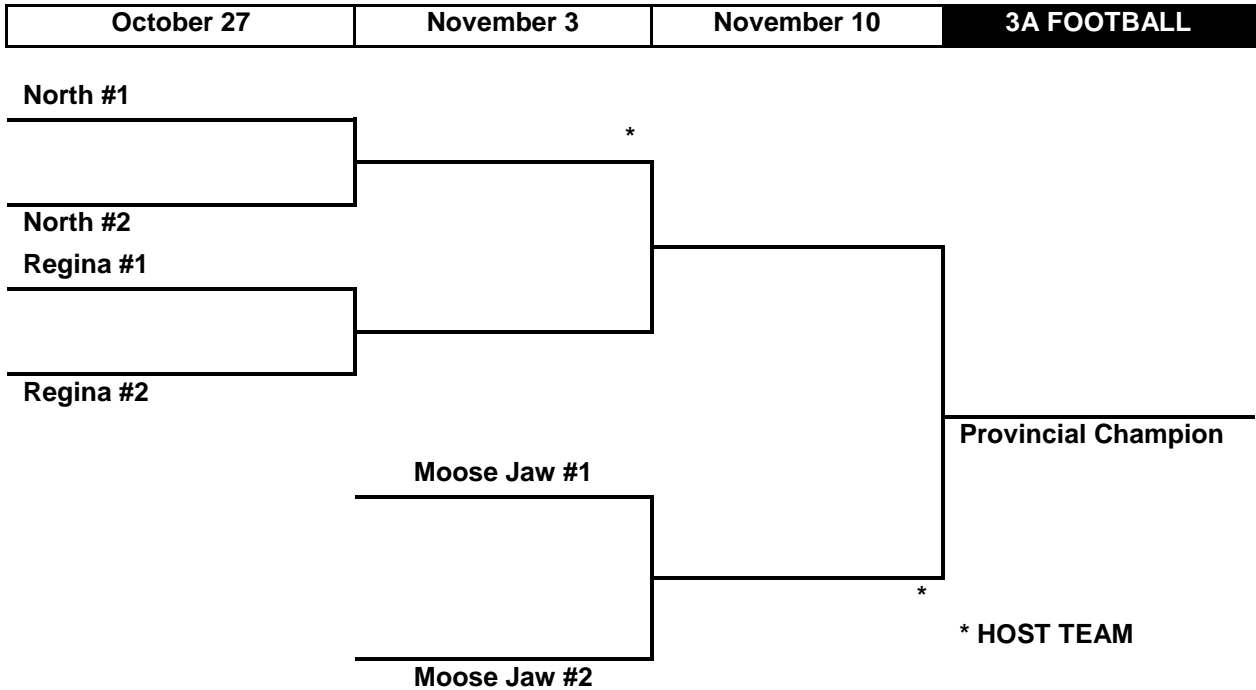

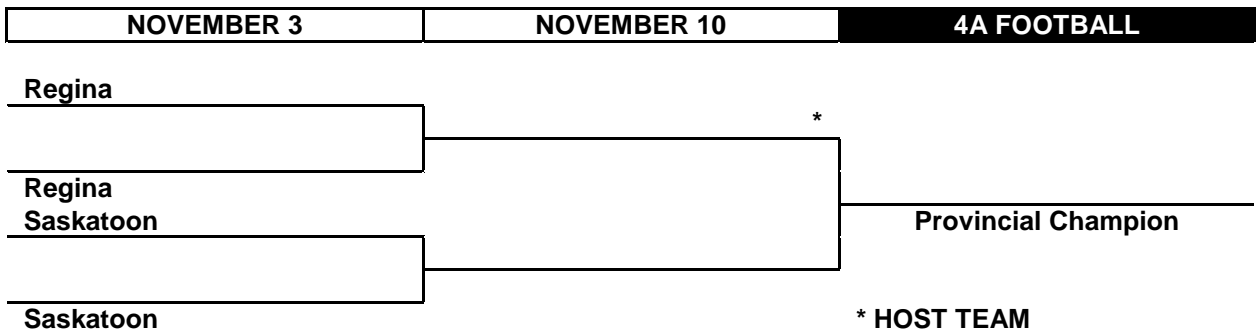
