

2007 PROVINCIAL VOLLEYBALL CHAMPIONSHIPS

The information printed here will include all preliminary material that teams will need for the volleyball playoffs leading to the provincial championship. Schedules and volleyball information are found in the SHSAA Handbook. The SHSAA office will seed each tournament. **Please notify the SHSAA office of the conference champions and runners-up immediately following the conference championship, as well as the top two finalists of each Regional tournament.**

- **Seeding** of the conference, regional and provincial tournaments are important to the success of the events. All teams **MUST** submit the results of their season to the **SHSAA office before October 26th**. Include results of all matches played up to that date.
- All provincial 1A – 5A tournaments will follow the ten-team round robin – 2 pools – 2 courts draw on page 119 of the SHSAA handbook. Some modification of the draw times may be necessary to accommodate host plans. The SHSAA office must approve changes to the draw.
- **Accommodations** in some locations may be limited. If your championship is near a city with a Comfort Inn, blocks of rooms have been set aside for the playoff. You may want to consider the Saskatoon Inn, Regina Inn and Quality Hotels.
- **Results for** Conference, Regional and Provincial events will be posted on the SHSAA web site (see SHSAA Results) as the events occur.

PLAYOFFS LEADING TO THE PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIP:

CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP

All teams registered for volleyball will be placed in one of four regions and then subdivided into conference groups. Each conference will play off to determine conference representatives advancing to the regional competition. Regions with **ten or fewer teams** will advance directly to a regional playoff with no conference playoff conducted. Regions with **eleven or more teams** will be divided into three conference tournaments with two teams advancing from each conference tournament to the regional tournament.

A final listing of the volleyball conferences is listed in this document.

Conference playoffs may consist of the following draws: less than six teams the conference tournament will consist of a full round-robin tournament with **no playoff round**. The 6-team conference tournament will consist of two pools of 3, with the top two teams advancing to the playoff round. All these conference tournaments will be played as one-day events. A seven or eight team conference tournament will consist of two pools, with the top 2 teams in each pool advancing to the playoff round. These conference tournaments will be played as a 1.5 day event. Details for the various draws will be listed on the SHSAA web site.

In the 1A to 4A classifications, conference playoff for girls will be held on or before November 3rd. Conference playoffs for boys will be held on or before Nov. 10th. In the 5A classification no conference playoffs will be held and all teams will advance to either the city league playoff or the north/south regional tournament to determine the provincial representatives.

REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

The top two teams from each conference playoff will advance to the regional level of playoffs. Regional tournaments, in most instances, will be six-team tournaments played as two pools of 3 teams, with the top two teams from each pool advancing to a playoff round, that will determine two teams to advance to the provincial final tournament. In some instances, when a conference playoff is not necessary, the regional may consist of nine or ten teams and will be conducted as 2 pools, advancing the top two teams in each pool to a playoff round to determine two representatives to advance to the provincial final tournament.

REGIONAL DATES:

5A Boys and Girls	- November 9th & 10th, 2007

The following districts have been designated to host the regional tournament. There is no provision for a host team in any of the regional tournaments; therefore, the host locations will be determined once the conference championships have been completed. Each District Council is responsible to ensure a host for the regional event with a suitable venue and tournament committee. The District should designate a host school from the teams that advance to the regional from conference playoffs. In the event that a district designated to host a regional does not have any teams that qualify from the conference playoffs, the SHSAA office will select the regional site from the qualified teams.

In the 5A classification, there will be four regional tournaments: Saskatoon (Conference 1), Regina (Conference 2), North (Conference 3) and South (Conference 4). The Saskatoon and Regina regional representatives (2 each) will be determined through their respective leagues. The North and South regional tournaments will consist of eight teams – 2 pools round robin. The top three teams in each pool after round robin play will compete in a single-elimination playoff to determine the top four places. The North and South Regional will send the top three teams to provincials. If either of the North or South Regional is hosting the provincial tournament, then that regional will only send two teams to provincials.

PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

The top two teams in each regional will qualify for the provincial championship. The provincial final tournament will include the eight regional qualifiers, the host team plus a third representative team from the regional championship that includes the 2006 Provincial Champion. In the event that the host school is in the same regional as the previous year's provincial champion only three teams may advance to the provincial and the 3rd rep will be awarded to another regional tournament. The 5A North and South Regional Tournaments have been selected by the SHSAA Executive and are:
