## **2010 PROVINCIAL FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIPS**

**ELIGIBILITY:** Student athlete eligibility forms (E - 5) must be filed in the SHSAA office on or before **September 8<sup>th</sup>**. Forms must be filled out and filed on-line via the SHSAA web site ([www.shsaa.ca](http://www.shsaa.ca)).

**OFFICIALS:** Game officials for all post conference or post league games are assigned, and paid, by the SHSAA office. The assignments are done by the District Officials Commissioner and must be approved by the SHSAA office.

**SPECIAL RULES:** Please note the information in the SHSAA handbook; refer to your particular category of football in the Activities section. Note the overtime procedure for high school football.

**GAME TIME:** Playoff games are scheduled for 1:00 p.m. unless otherwise stated or the teams involved agree to a time change and receive approval from the SHSAA office.

**GAME BALL:** The official game ball for football will be the **Wilson F2000**.

**TEAM COLORS:** If the competing teams have similar colour uniforms, and this would cause a problem, it is the responsibility of the home team to change.

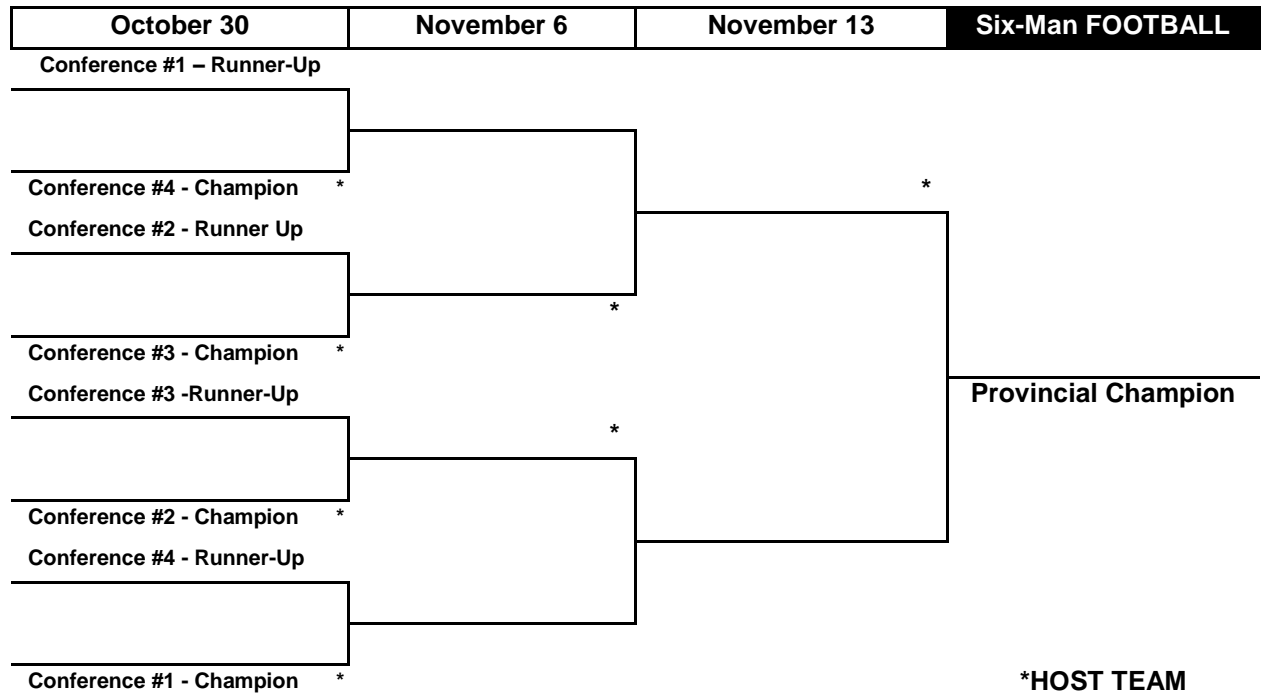
**PROVINCIAL PLAYOFF DRAW:** The draw template and schedule for each provincial championship appears later in this document.

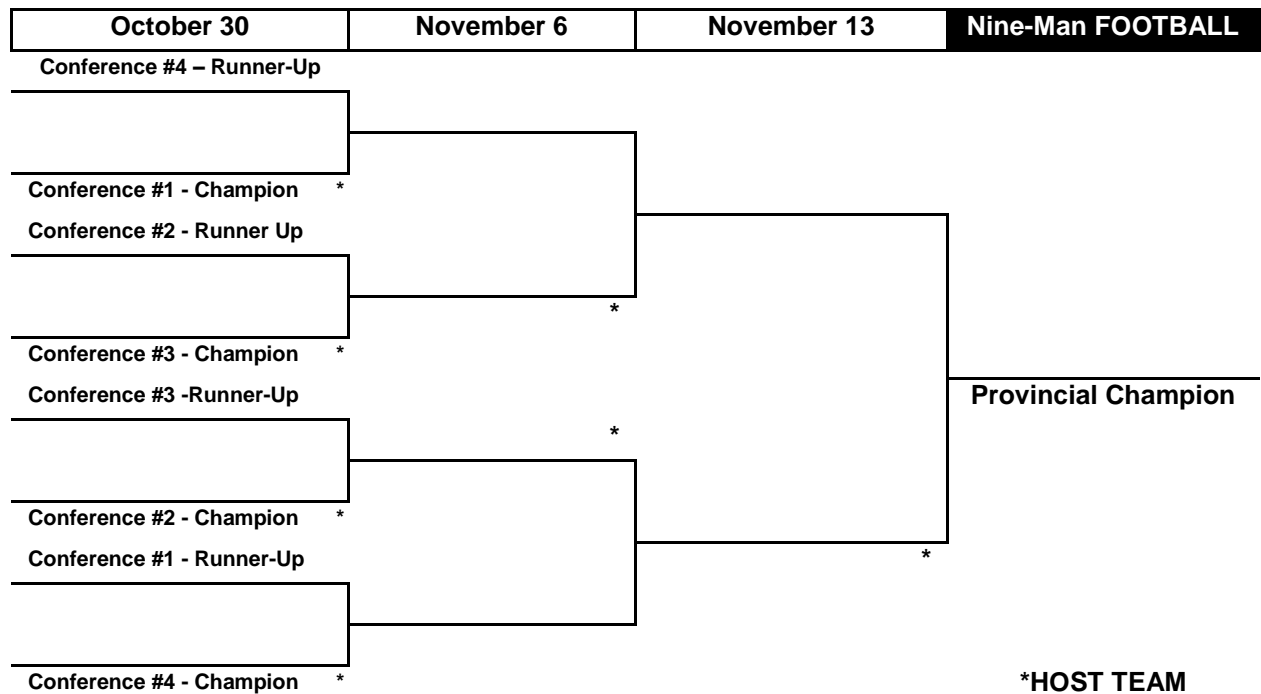

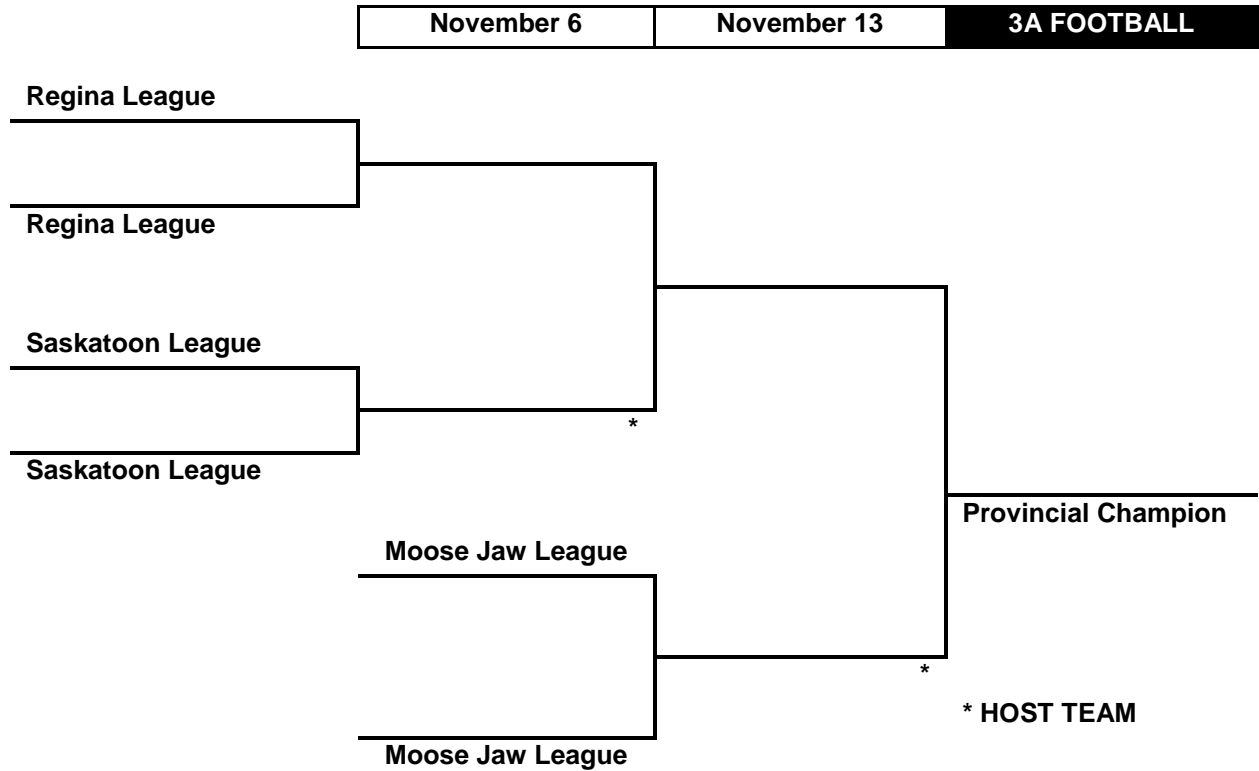
