3. Volleyball Officials:

- Gord Dayman will be stepping down as Assigner of Officials. I will forward the new contact information when it is received.
- Minor Officials clinic is tentatively set for Wednesday September 3 at Balfour. More information to follow.
- O'Neill has suggested that all linespersons for league games be volleyball players. Most teams are currently using this format. Concern was expressed from teams that may only have 6 or 7 players. Coaches agreed that this was the best solution but decided against a motion. Teams will continue to try and actively use members of their teams.
- Mentorship program will be continued for recruitment of new officials.

6. League Structure:
