- All competitors must dress in predominately white uniform or in a school uniform that reflects the school colors. Pg 79 SHSAA Handbook
- **All jewelry must be removed for any SHSAA sanctioned interschool athletic event except golf and curling. Page 61 SHSAA Handbook**
- It is mandatory that all **Public Schools** wear glasses (protective eyewear) in singles and doubles. **Non Regina Public Schools** must wear glasses in singles and doubles when competing at a public school venue.
