3. Presidents Report:
 - Classification Resolution June AGM – Schools Classification will be determined by September 30 enrolment from previous year. School can re – classify if population of school increases or decreases by 25%
4. Football:
 - City of Regina and Regina Public School Busing face same situation – buses not available between 3:00 and 4:30
 - Early game times of first game of doubleheaders moved to 5:15 in some cases to help bus schedule.
 - Swift Current is eligible for 4A Provincial as per June 2008 resolution.
 - 3A Provincial; Final – Mark Anderson has offered to help
 - Security: It is suggested that resource officers be employed as added security. Darren Boldt will look into possibility. Resource officers to assist and advise security.
 - 3A Provincial Final in Regina – Chuck will supervise. Greg will be in Calgary at daughter’s convocation.
