3. Rules and Regulations:

- SHSAA AGM Resolutions – Regina motion to have challenge matches was defeated
- Wrestlers with braces must wear a mouth guard - passed
- High amplitude throw is 3 pts and not 5 pts – passed
- Please see Athletic Director for copy of SHSAA Handbook

4. Coaches Rules Committee:

- A three person committee to review current rules was created. Committee members are Mike Dyck (Knoll), Rob Koroluk (Sheldon) and Mark Fitzpatrick (Miller)

5. Referees Clinic:

- Ryan Forsberg will be contacted to discuss a possible date for a clinic for new officials

6. Review of 2007 Season:

- Concern expressed over consistency of meet times – 2008 - 2009 meet times will be set for 5:00 pm. This will be based on referee availability.

- Schedule considerations larger schools were involved in dual meets - 28 – 2009 large schools will wrestle single meet where possible. Coaches will be asked to submit number of wrestlers prior to creating the schedule.
- Deadline for entries was good – 2008 – 2009 same process – **Entries due 8:30 am to RHSAA office the day of the meet.**
