- Information re: web site, sanctioned tournaments, tournament listings, SHSAA forms online, coaches symposium, school sports week, bids to host prov. Championships, coaches cards etc, can be found in the SHSAA Sept. 2006 bulletin. It can also be found on the SHSAA website (www.shsaa.ca)
 - The province was divided into 14 districts and four sections: Section 1: Regina, South West and South Central
 - Teams involved in the classified activities will qualify for regional and provincial playoffs through conferences
 - The eligibility deadline dates for submission of eligibility forms have been altered.
 - Admission rates have been increased for adults (6.00) and students (\$4.00) for all provincial championships. Conferences and regional admission rates stay the same.
 - Official's pay scale has been increased for basketball and wrestling. Mileage allowance has been ratified to \$.30/km and per Diems increased to \$10.00 per meal.
 - An outstanding official's award has been approved for each district.
 - Basketball will now be divided into five classifications.

- E5forms important to get all of the names: Should list everyone who tried out for the team, you want to count them on the eligibility forms; if you have a student who has transferred or is ineligible you will get a red flag. It's important to list all students because it coincides with how much money we get from Sask. Sport
 - The Officials registry has been wiped clean, they all have to be re-registered. They need to be approved by the school and therefore the school board, we need to make officials recruitment and retainment a priority. Need to redevelop the data base for the SHSAA,
 - All Moose Jaw officials will be listed under Central High School: Larry Segall will do that for Moose Jaw
 - Coach's symposium was great: over 130 attending
