6. **Special Reports and Presentations**

- 6.1 **SHSAA District President's Meeting:** Ryan Hall & Larry Segall
* Coaches symposium: Inquiry did anyone attend from SCDA?
* SHSAA forms are required today for basketball and curling
* Need to register our junior teams: send in \$35.00 and we get back \$40.00 from SHSAA.

Note: All forms for our district have been completed and sent in: We need to put all the athletes down, more students on E5 the better: list all that come out for try- outs as this is how we get calculated numbers for the Map grant Money from Sask. Lotteries: We pay \$35.00 per team: and get \$40.00 back

- 6.2 **Cross country:** Had to ask for the medals back from Delisle (wrong calculations were done at the meet)

- 2007: provincials in PA
- Gator was taken away, so didn't have any way of transporting injured people,
- The starter brought the wrong shells; therefore there were several hold ups.

- 6.3 **Soccer:** Thank you to all who helped out and ran the Provincial soccer tournament and regional playoffs.

- Concern re: 4 team Prov. Tournament, All coaches expressed dissatisfaction at this format and would like to return to the 8 team play off

6.4 **Football** is the only SHSAA sport played on Remembrance Day: all the rest start early, there is a link between the two. A past U of S Husky football player was a soldier and was killed. There is now a script made up for the announcer to read to explain the connection. All games had a program and brief moment of silence...reaches a lot of people.

- Helmets: Need to see the players eyes if they have an injury and : helmets aren't to be removed
- SHSAA: sending letters to the doctors explaining why players should not be wearing tinted visors. (Regina) the athlete actually has to take the letter to the doctor and have them sign. **Larry will get the letter from Greg (Regina)**
- 9 Man - Information SHSAA website. If you have concerns you need to contact the SHSAA
- 12 Man: may have more teams: could have as many as 4 - 3A leagues next year. May bump schedule up by a week next year.

6.5 **Volleyball** could lose \$10,000 this year. It is the biggest participation sport in the Prov.

- Regional schedule: most coaches didn't like it. I.e. game times, starts, wait between games etc
- SHSAA: looking at bringing forth the 10 team concept
Eliminate 3rd place teams from each....
- Less loss of school time, for the 10 team format

6.6 **Golf** having adults with each team helped speed up play

- Athletes exhibited better behaviour
- Athletes felt more able to challenge scores
- There were no complaints about scoring
- good golfers who knew how to score: was a waste of time for the adults
- more positives than negatives

6.7 **Miscellaneous**

- Trying to make the SHSAA website more user friendly. This will be done for next year.
- Officials: Want to continue mentoring programs. Have officials paid at the SHSAA rate, some concerns re: refs demanding more money.
- Withdrawals from playoffs: Some were appealed and some were granted.

Some teams decided they weren't going to play the conciliation game soccer and went home. Majority of teams participated, and consider the conference tournament as the last tournament of the season.

- Forward planning: SABO a pleasure to work with this year. Changes are posted on the website.
- E5 deadline: will be fined \$50.00 can withdraw from basketball, and must by FEB. 1/07, need to send a letter from your Principal.
- Larry has some basketball initiatives for our out of school basketball coaches: will make copies if wanted.
- Coaches symposium: August 20 & 21, 2007
- June AGM Lloydminster June 20 – 22, 2007
- We should host for the Volleyball 5A girls and 2A boys 2007 need to be done by Jan. 30, 2007
- Ryan: SCDA has one of the best set ups as far as being organized and prepared in the province. The presidents did a round table discussion: The SCDA and the school boards affiliated with us were sensible, realistic, generous in running our athletic programs. Our district is far ahead of everyone else.
