Re: Recognition of Volunteer Coaches and Officials in South Central

I am writing to make you aware of the recognition programs that exist within the SHSAA and South Central District. In many cases, the most worthy recipients of the recognition are the individuals that nominate others for recognition. I would appreciate if you could take a few minutes to take the time to nominate a volunteer for recognition if there is a worthy recipient in your school. Keep in mind that if an individual has received one of the following awards, they are still eligible for other awards in the list.

1. SHSAA Provincial Merit Award

Description – The highest honor SHSAA bestows upon a volunteer. It honours people who have given outstanding leadership and service to the SHSAA and to the promotion of high school athletics in the province of Saskatchewan. Nominees need not have been official representatives of the SHSAA.

Criteria

- A Merit Award nomination will be accepted for a person who has made outstanding contributions to the TOTAL PROGRAM of the SHSAA over a period of time.
- Selection of Recipients of this award rests with the Awards Committee of the SHSAA Executive.
- A Merit Award form (E-12 from SHSAA Handbook), citation, and photograph are to be completed in full by April 30th.

Quantity – 1 to 3 are awarded in Saskatchewan annually at the SHSAA Annual General Meeting

2. SHSAA Provincial Service Award

Description – It honours one person in the district who has provided outstanding leadership and service and the promotion of high school athletics in the district

Criteria

- A Service Award nomination will be accepted from each district, for a person who has made contributions to the high school sports in a LIMITED area over a period of time.
- Selection of Recipients of this award rests with the Awards Committee of the SCDA Executive.
- A Service Award form needs to be submitted to the district president prior to the April SCDA executive meeting.

Quantity – One may be awarded annually to a South Central volunteer at the SHSAA Annual General Meeting

3. SCDAAs District Service Award

Description – It honours individuals in the district who have provided outstanding leadership and the promotion of high school athletics in their local school or section.

Criteria

- a) A Service Award nomination will be accepted from each school, for a person who has made contributions to the high school sports in their school over a period of time.
- b) Selection of Recipients of this award rests with the Awards Committee of the SCDAAs Executive.
- c) A nomination form needs to be submitted to the district president prior to the April SCDAAs executive meeting.

Quantity – Up to 4 may be awarded annually. Recipients may be coaches, administrators, or officials. One award is presented to a non-faculty coach.

4. Outstanding Coach Award

Description – Recognizes outstanding contributions of individuals in the coaching field.

Criteria

- a) Conducting an outstanding program where student athletes learn a vast amount about the game and life.
- b) Act as a proponent of good sportsmanship and instill these ideals through their coaching and interaction with athletes.
- c) Attempt to involve their entire school in the total program.
- d) A nomination form needs to be submitted to the district president prior to the April SCDAAs executive meeting.

Quantity – One male and one female coach may be awarded in South Central. The award will be presented at the coach's school.

5. Outstanding Official Award

Description – Recognizes outstanding contributions of individuals in the officiating field.

Criteria

- a) Contribute to the district by providing a valuable service to the activities offered by the district.
- b) Act as a proponent of good sportsmanship by officiating with these ideals in mind whenever officiating.
- c) Regularly attending clinics in the activity officiated to show an interest in improving and keeping up to date with the current trends in officiating.
- d) A nomination form needs to be submitted to the district president prior to the April SCDAAs executive meeting.

Quantity – One officials award may be awarded in South Central. The award will be presented at a district event.

Our **Years of Service** recognition program awards certificates at 5, 10, and 15 years, and a plaque at 20, 25, and 30 years of volunteer contributions to extra curricular sports in our district. The names for these awards are contributed by the athletic directors of each school.

Enclosed are recipients of previous awards in the South Central District, and nomination forms for South Central District Service Awards and SHSAA Provincial Coaching and Officiating Awards.
