discussion was held on the need for a budget and was decided that it was not necessary

vii) Old/Unfinished Business:

1. *SCD Officials list* - it is on our site and members are encouraged to add names
2. *Minimum age/grade for junior competition* - discussion held on whether the type of sport could dictate decisions or that special permission may be sought, it was decided to leave for now and discuss more in the future
3. *District Champion Archive* - it is now online and track and field were added.
 4. *Outstanding Fines* - Bengough(boys bball, boys/girls curling, boys/girls wrestling), Crane Valley(t&f), Briercrest(boys/girls curling), Lang(t&f, badminton), Notre Dame(t&f), and Rockglen(boys bball) were reminded to get these fines into SHSAA asap.
5. *Alternate School Year* -GPSD has been okayed for another one year term.
6. *Coaches symposium bursary* - there is one left for someone to claim
7. *Coaches certificates and plaques* - these were passed out to the appropriate people
8. *Track and Field records certificates and remaining medals* - these were distributed
9. *SHSAA Web Site* - some find it hard to print things off of it and there were no Badminton results posted
10. *SCDAA Web Site* - kudos to our site was passed on that came from a parent, Guy's Track report was congratulated, it would be beneficial if we could fill out forms right on site.
11. *Jr. Golf Update* - Kevin reported that 60 golfers were registered and will still accept golfers until tomorrow.

viii) District Championship Commissioners' Reports:

1. *Sr. Badminton* - Ryan distributed reports, some concerns on uniform non-conformity were mentioned, it was suggested that the two divisions which do not

host badminton should rotate as a helper to oversee at the alternate gym, eg. Borderland/Red Coat in Gravelbourg and Prairie View/Herbert in Caronport.

2. *Jr. Badminton* - Jody L. distributed reports, Coronach boys withdrew too late and will be fined \$50.00.
3. *Track & Field* - Guy distributed reports, booth and bathroom issues were discussed, dress codes were discussed in regards with no shirts and no numbers visible and that the dress code needs to be reinforced in the manual and by all the officials and those in violation could be fined \$50. It was suggested that the official commissioner should coordinate all officials. There is a walkie-talkie missing (these should be labelled). Provincials has to have names of officials, we need to *assign* a District coach, maybe make sure each division coach has a walkie-talkie, and a list of where everybody is staying should be distributed.
4. *District track scratches* - discussion was held on why this happened and what was done, there is a need to have better communication so that a 3rd place athlete does not miss an opportunity to compete at this level.
